Q & A

What to expect from attending this camp?

Offensively:

You can expect to get more than 10 swings. We will have each hitter take a maximum of 20 swings per station. We will be using 4 fields for the Offensive hitting session and each player will rotate to every field providing a different series of drills for Coaches to observe.

Defensively:

You can expect to throw more than 10 throws. We will have this session broken down according to classification. We will have different groups allowing a simulated defense. (This is if we have the estimated amount of players we are expecting) When you are not on the field you will have a College Coach talk to your group about College softball and what to prepare for and expect. Please feel free to ask any questions to the College Coaches.

Pitchers:

We will separate the pitchers by classification and use 2 fields for this session. Pitchers will get clocked at each station. The first stations will be only a fastball and changeup station. This will allow Coaches to see your pitch speed variation. The second station will be the other pitches you throw (ex. curveball, screwball...ect). Every pitch will be clocked and each pitch will be thrown three times. If we do not reach the estimated amount of pitchers attending this session we will have everyone throw more.

Catchers:

You will be timed on "pop time" from home to second. The "pop time" will be timed from the moment the ball enters your glove until the ball reaches second base. You will also go through series of blocking drills, as well as throwing to first base and third base.

Individual Session with College Coaches:

College Coaches will be present at each individual session. We will use four fields and we are only allowing 20 players to sign up per session. This will allow each athlete to receive more one on one instruction. You will get to experience what College Coaches expect from Elite athletes and the types of drills and knowledge Coaches expect from their athletes.

What will the Coaches receive about me?

Every College and University that attends the camp will be provided with your player profile along with other information. It is very important that you fill out the online players profile sheet as accurately as possible. This will help the Coaches contact you or follow your softball career for the upcoming season or years to come.

If you listed additional colleges who are not working this camp we will contact the colleges and/or universities and inform them of your interest. Although we can not guarantee their participation we feel that many of the closer colleges and universities might attend.

Can I talk with all the College Coaches watching the camp?

Some Universities or Colleges attending the camp are allowed to talk to the athletes further if they are interested in you being a part of their program. However please get updated on the rules of NCAA of how the recruiting process goes.

What should I expect to bring or wear?

You need to bring all softball equipment: Bat, gloves, catchers gear, cleats, and you need to dress according to the weather.

Bat

Batting helmet

Batting gloves

Fielding Glove and/or Catchers Mitt

Cleats (metal or rubber spikes are permitted)

If you are graduating in 2009 you must wear a gray t-shirt. If you are graduating in 2010 you must wear a navy t-shirt. 2011 graduates must wear a red t-shirt, and 2012 graduates must wear a white t-shirt. It is EXTREMELY important that you wear your designated color. We will provide you with a number to attach to your t-shirt making it easier for College Coaches to identify you and review your profile.

What if it is cancelled due to weather?

We will only allow refunds if the camp is cancelled due to weather. We will not be able to reschedule but we hope that you will attend next year and we will still provide the Colleges and Universities of your choice with your information.

We will inform all campers online if the camp is cancelled due to weather. We acknowledge that some of our campers might be traveling a good distance to attend this camp and we will do everything in our power to inform you ahead of time if the camp must be cancelled due to weather.
