New Freshman Undergraduate Enrollment by Residence

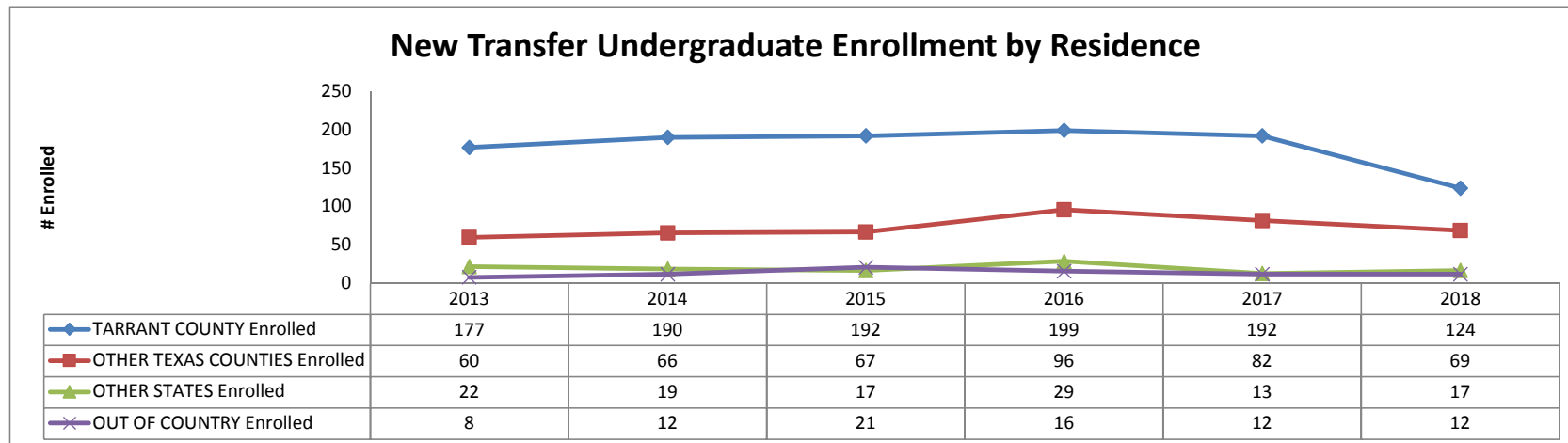

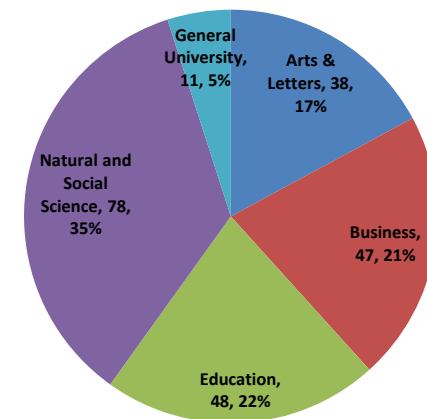
