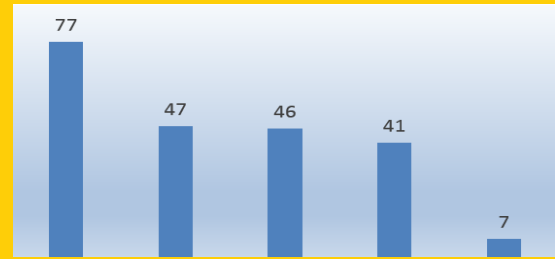
ENROLLMENT BY SCHOOL

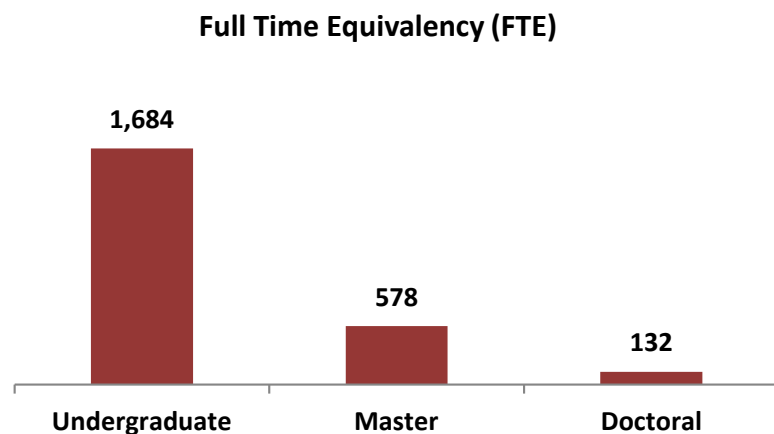
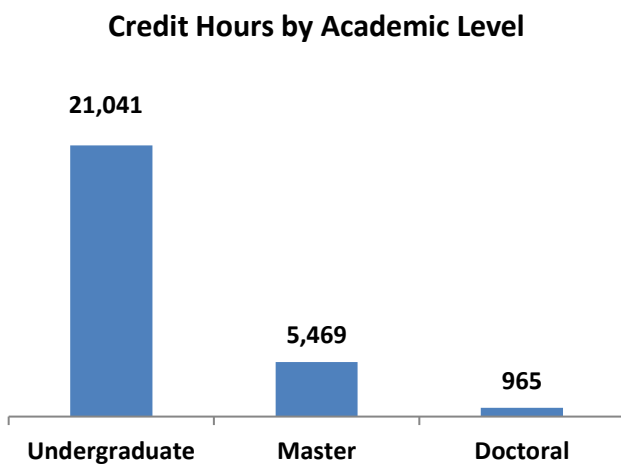
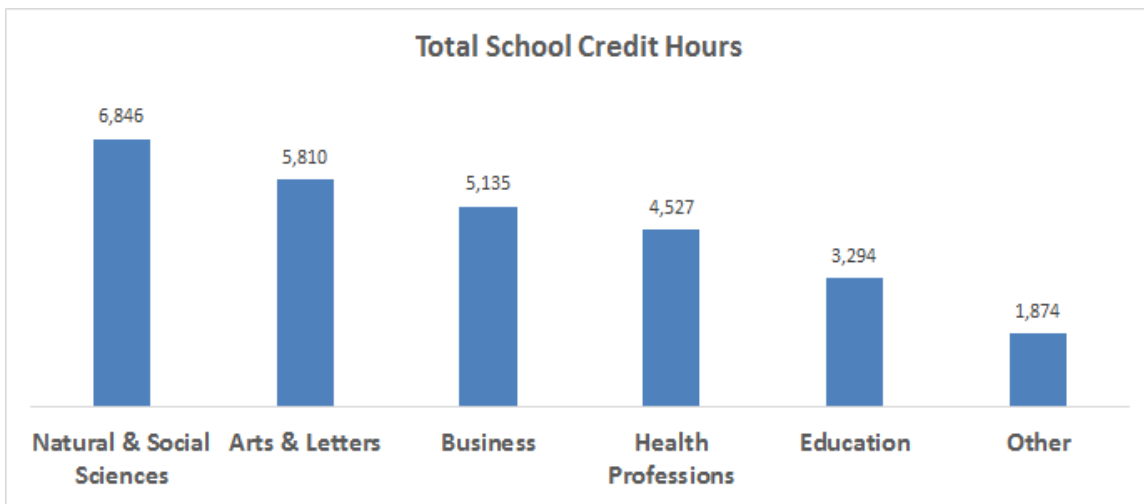
