Graduation Rates of Transfer Cohorts by School 2009 - 2014

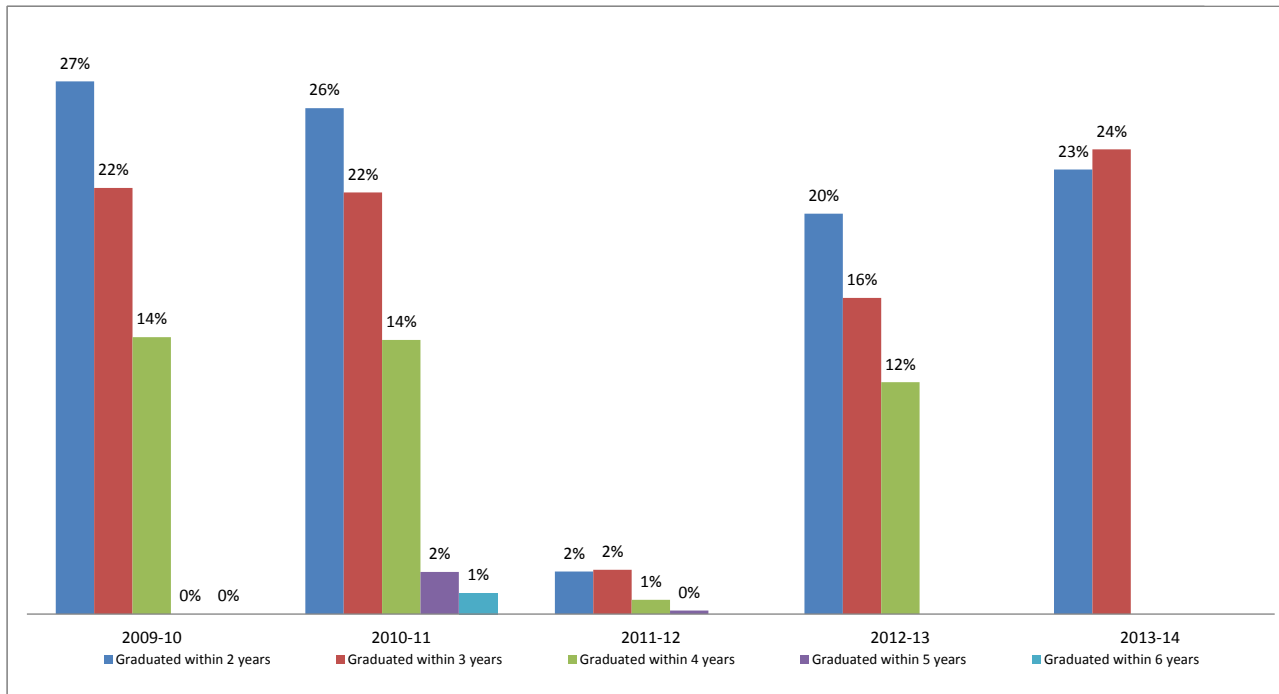
